



# CTRL – Digital Confidence Assessment

#### What is it?

- Digital confidence assessment
- Presents 16 generic workplace scenarios
- Users rate their confidence they have the necessary digital skills in each scenario
- A report is generated immediately, and emailed as a PDF, giving scores and suggested resources to develop digital skills



# Creation Transaction Responsibility Learning

CREATION covers creating digital resources, digital research skills, assessing suitability of different tools, as well as managing and backing up digital assets.

TRANSACTION covers digital communication, marketing and promotion, data and records, planning and collaboration.

RESPONSIBILITY covers digital accessibility and inclusion, maintaining device and data security, managing and promoting wellbeing online, and self-sufficiency in problem solving.

LEARNING covers participation in online continuous professional development and training, planning and creation of learning for digital platforms, planning and delivery of learning, guidance and coaching online.


# Example scenario

You start working with an organisation or institution which uses a different productivity suite to the one you normally use.

You need to adapt quickly, creating resources and communicating using their suite (e.g. MS Office, Outlook and Teams if you mainly use Google G-Suite and Hangouts, or G-Suite, Gmail and Hangouts if you normally use Office, Outlook and Teams).

1= not confident at all; 2= maybe with some help; 3= quite confident; and 4= fully confident.
